YAA is a program that encourages children's creative and mental growth through meaningful visual experiences in a non-judgmental environment. YAA present 6 art projects throughout the year encompassing a variety of techniques and artists.

We require one parent volunteer per class to coordinate the projects.

Participating in the program requires that you attend a Tuesday workshop once a month from 9 to 11:15 where you will learn how to teach the art project to the kids. There are 6 morning workshops, held at American Martyrs church. Over 200 parents attend and buffet breakfast is served.

Following the workshop, you have one month to teach the project to the kids in your class. Teaching in the room takes about 1 ½ hours including setup and cleanup. You can call on other parents from your class to assist. At the end of the year, YAA organizes an art show where the children's art is displayed.

There are no costs involved for you and no art experience is required.
